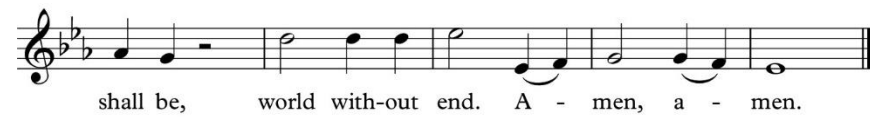
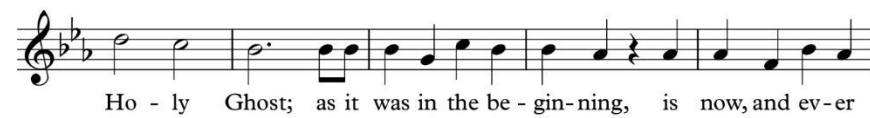
**Assurance of Pardon**

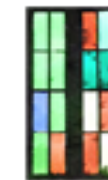
