the word that he commanded, for a thousand generations.

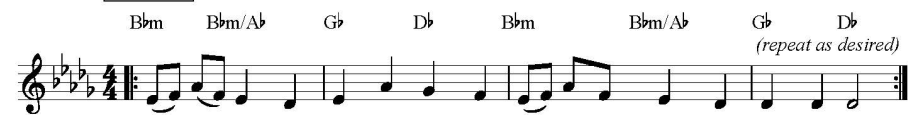

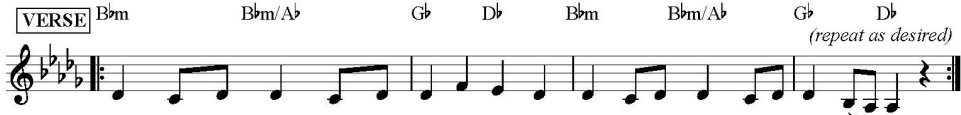

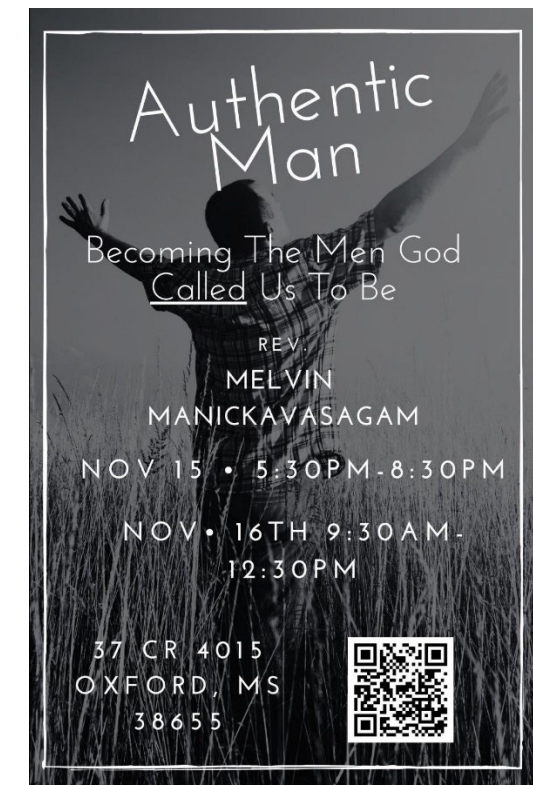
