PEOPLE: From you comes my praise in the great congregation; my vows I will perform before those who fear him.


ELDER: The afflicted shall eat and be satisfied; those who seek him shall praise the Lord! May your hearts live forever!

ELDER: Why is the Son of God called "Jesus," meaning "savior"?

ALL. Because he saves us from our sins, and because salvation should not be sought and cannot be found in anyone else.

ELDER: Do those who look for their salvation and security in themselves or elsewhere really believe in the only savior Jesus?

ALL: No. Although they boast of being his, by their actions they deny the only savior, Jesus. Either Jesus is not a perfect savior, or those who in true faith accept this savior have in him all they need for their salvation.

ELDER: Why is he called "Christ," meaning "anointed"?

ALL: Because he has been ordained by God the Father and has been anointed with the Holy Spirit to be our chief prophet and teacher who perfectly reveals to us the secret counsel and will of God for our deliverance; our only high priest who has set us free by the one sacrifice of his body, and who continually pleads our cause with the Father; and our eternal king who governs us by his Word and Spirit, and who guards us and keeps us in the freedom he has won for us.




